



Sutherland Hockey Club Junior Academy Participation Eligibility

Academy Aim:

To provide a positive and worthwhile training experience for both the Academy coaches and players to improve player skills and knowledge of hockey.

Selection Criteria:

The Sutherland Hockey Club Junior Academy is open for both boys and girls in U11, U13, U15 age groups. Players are nominated by their respective club coaches in the current year. In order to be considered for nomination players must meet the following criteria:

- Participants must be financial to Sutherland club in the current year.
- Participants cannot be registered to play in two or more hockey clubs within the same association. i.e. They can only be registered and play for Sutherland Hockey club to be eligible for consideration.
- Participants must have played 1 full season in the previous year with Sutherland
- Participants must show a positive attitude, good work ethic, a willingness to listen & learn about the game and be a team player.
- Participants must show willingness to practice skills on their own.
- Participants must be a current representative player or with the potential or goal to be a representative player in the future.
- Participants must show the right attitude to the Sutherland Hockey club, their club coach and fellow team mates.
- Players nominated do not need to be the best players in the team currently but have the potential to improve if given the opportunity.

Additional Information:

- Participation in the academy is completely optional and players/parents can decide not to participate and this has no bearing on further Sutherland Hockey Club team selections.
